All Cabinet collections are produced in their Somerset studio and materials continue to be sourced from fair-trade, eco-friendly or vintage sources.

With forthcoming collaborations with Paul Smith and The V&A Museum as well as international ventures, 2010 looks to be an exciting year for the British design duo.
